For fourteen years, he faithfully served in the New Zealand deanery of our diocese, devoting all his energy, warmth of heart, and love to his flock. He worked tirelessly, humbly, and selflessly, receiving a salary barely sufficient to support his family.

Father Alexander leaves behind his beloved wife and young son, who will have to endure this grievous loss, these will be days of trial and sorrow for them. Not long ago, their home was filled with joy and warmth, and now they are left without a husband, father, and sole breadwinner. They may soon have to look for new housing, as their current rent will become unaffordable.

We are all called to demonstrate Christian love and mercy. As Holy Scripture says: "Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble ..." (James 1:27). May our hearts respond to the needs of Father Alexander's family, for this is an opportunity to perform a kind and virtuous act of love.

On Sunday, November 2, I direct all rectors to announce from the amyon a collection in aid of the Skorik family, to take place on Sunday, November 9. Parishes are also encouraged, if possible, to supplement this general collection with donations from parish charitable funds.
